

Departure from Normal Temperature (F) 6/1/2010 - 6/29/2010



The outstanding features of the June temperatures have been the above average warmth across the Eastern half of the nation and the abnormally cool conditions throughout the Northwest tier of the nation.



The outstanding character of June's rainfall has been the lack of rain in the Southwestern states. In contrast, the Pacific Northwest and North Central states have seen excessive rainfall during the month of June.


When the previous conditions were compared with previous June's on a climate division level, the following years were selected as close analogs: 1952, 1944, 1914, 1954, 1943, 1925, 1998, 2008, 1953, and 1901.

Below are the conditions nationwide during the July-August that followed:










Applying those same analog years produced the following daily departures from normal for three regions of Pennsylvania for the period from July 1- August 31.
